



Michigan Auto No-Fault Insurance Law Change

Public Acts 21 and 22 of 2019 reformed Michigan's automobile no-fault insurance law. These changes will be effective July 1, 2020. One of the changes to the law is that individuals no longer need to have automobile coverage that includes unlimited PIP coverage, and they may select from other options.

The Thumb Group, Inc. BCBS medical plan excludes any services related to an injury that is a direct or indirect result of a motor vehicle accident.

What actions do employees need to take?

Employees should discuss PIP coverage and other auto coverage with their auto insurance agent to ensure they have the appropriate level of auto insurance elected.
